Moeller Celebrates Founder's Day by Honoring Two Awardees

CINCINNATI, January 23, 2015 –The Archbishop Moeller High School community recently celebrated Founder's Day and awarded two of its long-time supporters. The Founder's Day Award honors Moeller Family members who have given support over the years to the school's Marianist philosophy of education and who help create "Moementum For Life." This philosophy is grounded in five primary characteristics which are faith formation, a quality, integral education, Family Spirit, service, justice, and peace, and adaptation and change. This year's awardees are Karen Matuszek and Steve Klonne.

Steve Klonne has been a mentor and a community leader on and off the field for over 30 years. Steve was the head football coach and teacher at Moeller from 1982 – 2000, where he collected two state championships and a USA Today National Coach of the Year award. He has also been inducted into the Moeller, LaRosa's, and Hamilton County Halls of Fame. Whether he was coaching or teaching, Steve has been a staple to the Moeller community for years, serving as a role model for his students, players, and peers. Steve is currently continuing to serve the community as an assistant football coach.

Karen Matuszek has devoted her time and energy to embodying the Characteristics of a Marianist Education. She has led countless retreats across all grade levels. As one of the first House Deans at Moeller, Karen is truly a pioneer in one of the most wonderful things to happen at Moeller, The House System. The House System serves as Moeller's all-inclusive student government. As current Head of the House System, Karen ensures that Moeller students are educated in the Family Spirit, and makes it her goal that no student feels isolated during their time at Moeller. She embodies Mary's call to "do whatever he [Jesus] tells you" (John 2:5b).
